Minutes of a meeting of the Lighting Committee
held in the Community Centre on 26th January 2011 at 10.00

Attendance

Apologies had been received from Cllr. J. Willson.

Business of the Meeting (6506 / 01 / 11)

(a) Check with S.E.C. whether it would be feasible to change lanterns from sodium or amber type diffusers to natural light type as per the lanterns installed in 2010 at the junction of School Close and Plomer Geen Lane.

(b) Review existing locations of footway lights to see if there are any that are no longer needed, ie Turners Field since additional lights were installed by Barratts at Downley Park.

(c) The Clerk to contact Bucks County Council regarding the possibility of white lining along the kerbside of Plomer Green Lane from the junction of High Street to Downley Common.

As there is no pavement along this stretch of road, it was agreed that this was worth an enquiry.

(d) In respect of the 4 lighting columns on Downley Common, agreed that the Clerk obtain details of alternative lanterns, as the current type will need to be replaced shortly as they are being phased out.

(e) It was agreed that the Clerk contact S.E.C. regarding the column at Greenleys to remove this to another location. In the meantime, S.E.C. are still examining options on solar lighting.

(f) It was agreed that the committee look at the lanterns on the lighting columns in West Court and Mines Close in respect of options for other columns in Downley.

(g) The Clerk agreed to find out more details regarding the possibility of combining with other parish councils in the High Wycombe area on the principle of bulk buying of supply and of maintenance. This subject has been discussed by W.D.A.L.C. recently and is likely to be on the agenda of next Clerks meeting at Wycombe District Council in March.
